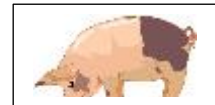
# Just for a few laughs

Eddie was driving down the road and met a car coming the other way.

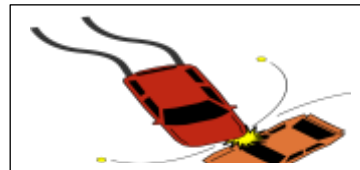
Although there was room to pass easily, Eddie forced the oncoming car to slow down and wound down his window and shouted 'Pig'.
