Dave Berry was one of the people who joined together to petition the AACA to have a region based in Northeast Tennessee. From that day on he was supportive of the club in many ways and usually at his own expense. Convertible Roadsters were obviously his favorite and his Ford and LaSalle were fixtures and crowd pleasers at local shows. From the time I met him, he was always hoping to acquire a Cord Beverly or Westchester. He was a member of the Auburn Cord Duesenberg for many years keeping a lookout for the elusive Cord. Dave's LaSalle went through the various level awards with AACA including a Grand National First Prize at a Meet in Cherry Hill, New Jersey.

At the Annual Region Christmas Banquet, he would distribute Antique Car Calendars to members for the coming year. His collection of automobilia and toys made for many interesting programs. His automated Santas entertained the club as well as folks in area senior living facilities.

For many years Dave made his annual pilgrimage to Hershey and to the AACA Annual Meeting in Philadelphia. Dave would often acquire the most interesting toy cars and hood ornaments to be found in the Hershey flea market. His enthusiasm for the old car hobby was consistent and contagious.

Dave was one of the most enthusiastic supporters of the AACA National Meets our region hosted in 1986, 1990 and 1996. He served the region as Historian, Newsletter Editor, Vice President and President and likely in more positions. He was also truly dedicated to his pharmacy business.
