I myself had the pleasure of recently visiting The Coker Museum in Chattanooga. This museum is a high-quality car museum featuring a wide range of vehicles, heavily leaning towards the 1930s and 1920s. Everything from a Magnum PI style Ferrari 308 to a Diamond T truck to an American Underslung. A collection of around 50 restored and original condition early motorcycles are featured, Harley-Davidson, Sears and Whizzer are seen on display. Numerous original neon signs and memorabilia abound. Engines such as V-12 Packard and many others are available to view.

One of the most interesting features at the museum, which has a working restoration shop World Famous Honest Charley Speed Shop, is a full wood shop that hand manufactures wooden spoke wheels for early automobiles. Several hundred wooden templates line the shop walls, in addition to a wide variety of wood working equipment allows the salvation of many an old car. I highly recommend visiting the Coker Car Museum in Chattanooga for those who haven't seen it.

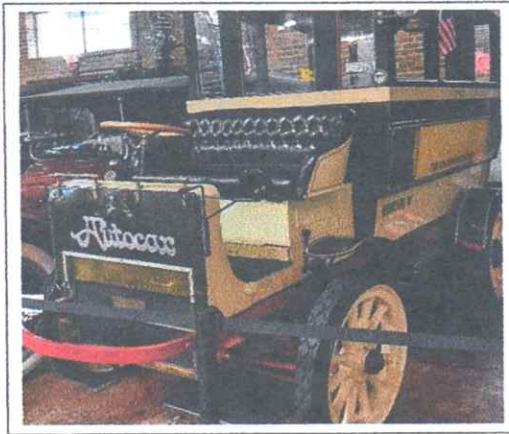
Due to scheduling conflicts in the month of March, Giuseppe's did not have our usual Tuesday available.
