From the Desk of President Marty Lane June 2023

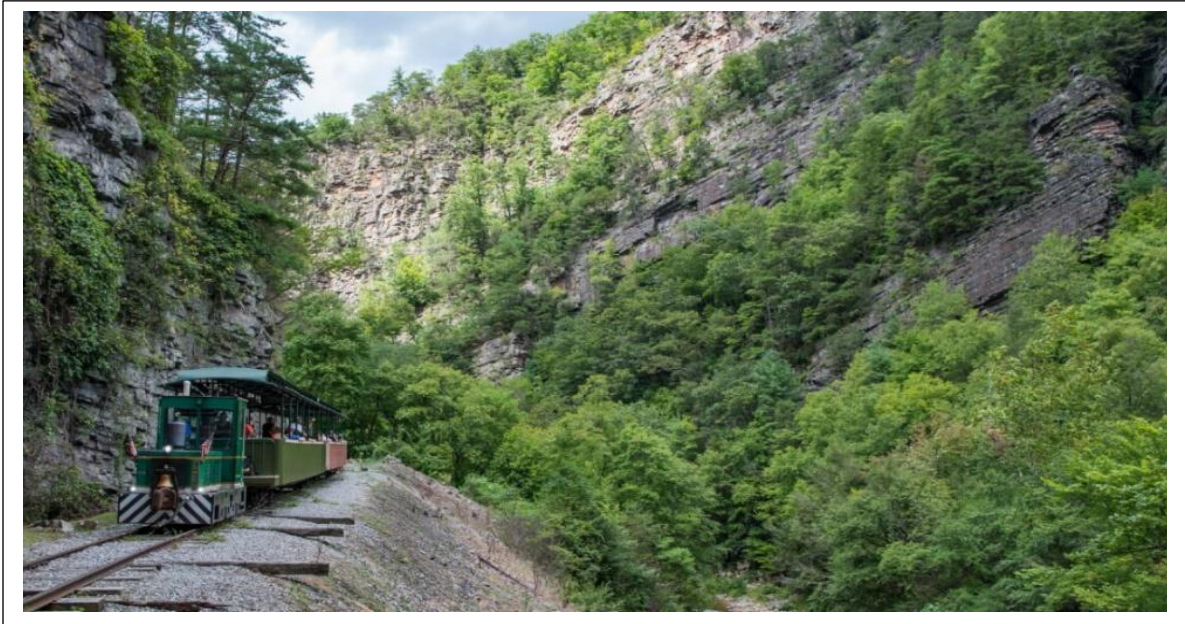


Greetings,
