After a career in teaching art, she took a riding academy class at Caliente Harley Davidson and bought a 2012 883SL Sportster, which she rides today.

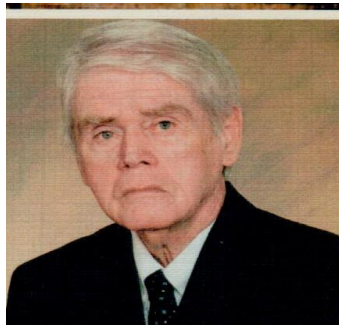
